
Here are two thoughts that inspire me. Hopefully, you also can find some positive meaning and relevance for you and your life journey.

Finance Report – November and December 2022

November and December have been busy months with plenty of smaller donations coming in to the branch. We have received another £500 grant from Herts County Council's Locality Budget Scheme making £2,250 in total over the year, a further £300 for Kent and Sue's Fundraiser, £76 from Keith James's Wing Walk, £240 via 'Text to Donate' and £106 from other donations and collection boxes. We also raised a remarkable £146 in the Christmas Lunch raffle and have received a further £367 in Gift Aid from HMRC, £845.49 for the year. I would like to thank Daniel Bourke and Belvoir Estates for their continued monthly support, as always, we are very grateful. We have already received £1,648 in donations in 2023.

Over the last 2 months we have been able to fund 2 wetroom adaptations, 1 riser recliner chair, 1 quality of life grant and 1 carer's grant with 2 more riser recliners in the pipeline for January. 2022 has proved to be a very successful year for the branch and our annual transfer to National office has been calculated as £4,067.46. Sunday 4th June – Gala Concert – Gordon Craig Theatre Stevenage – 7 pm


