* Finance Report – November and December 2023 *

As 2023 drew to a close it was time to reflect on what was definitely an unusual year. Merging the 2 branches brought with it several problems financially but these were finally ironed out by the end of July and with a few ups and downs, the processes have now become straight forward again. Obviously having one large branch has brought with it a much higher demand for grants but equally a great deal more generous donations and fundraising.

November and December were no exception, another £1,600 was donated to Paul Gilbert's Golf Day and a further £3,376 came to us from Mark O'Brien's Open Water Swim. We have received a further £455 from Letchworth RUFC, Our Committee Member Grant Cameron has raised over £800 by Walking 25 miles in December and Stotfold Town Council donated £230 collected when they turned on their Christmas Lights. Just before Christmas, London Building Control in Welwyn Garden City donated £1,000.

All of these generous donations mean we have a very comfortable financial position and have been able to meet all grant requests. During November and December We funded Riser Recliner Chairs, Stairlifts, House Adaptations, Taxi's to Meetings and Appointments, Holidays, several different types of Therapy and a Dog Walker, plus both Carers Grants and Young Peoples Grants.

We look forward to continuing to support everyone during 2024.

MNDA Research update

On 3rd November 2023 the New UK MND Research Institute (UK MND RI) was Launched. This is a Virtual Institute bringing together a Network of Labs working on MND to better coordinate a wide range of activities to accelerate drug discovery and development. The Institute is co-directed by Professors Ammar Al-Chalabi at King's College London and Chris McDermott at the University of Sheffield.

Clinical Trials update



Clene Nanomedicine (USA) have reported two key updates from their ongoing trial of their investigational CNM-Au8® treatment in ALS/MND participants. They have stated that there was a 60% decrease in long term mortality events between a group given the active treatment versus a group given a placebo (dummy drug).

The second important report was that the measurement of a protein in the blood called Neurofilament Light Chain (NfL) appears to correlate well with disease progression and the goal would be to use the NfL levels and changes as a biomarker for disease progression. Having a proven **biomarker** can be a significant step forward in monitoring and carrying out diagnosis and clinical trials as the results can be seen more quickly than current methods.

NeuroSense (USA) have reported 6-month data from a small, phase 2b study with their therapy Prime C. The potential treatment was stated to be safe and well tolerated by people with ALS. Prime C was also found to slow disease progression and slow decline in lung function compared to a placebo (dummy drug). Prime C is a novel formulation composed of two FDA-approved drugs, Ciprofloxacin and Celecoxib.

It should be noted that all these results above are from small, early stage clinical trials. However they are encouraging updates and will allow continued trials and additional larger trials where true clinical significance will be investigated in the coming years. Grant


