This is the name for 'Social Services' in Hertfordshire. The main 'Call Centre' and first point of contact is 0300-123-4042. Contact this number initially if you need to be assessed for equipment, Home Care Services, or need an adaptation to the Home (e.g., level access shower, ramp). You will need to explain the situation and then you will need to ask to be seen by an Occupational Therapist if you need equipment or adaptations to the home. Explain what the problem is and that you have MND (as you should not need to wait too long with this condition and should be seen as a priority). You can also apply for a Blue Badge - see website below.

NHS - Community Neuro Therapy - PHYSIOTHERAPY, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY, SPEECH AND LANGUAGE THERAPY, or DIETITIANS

You can be referred to the NHS Neurological Community Therapy Services in Hertfordshire, if you need to see any of the above Professionals, who specialise in Neurology. Speak to your GP or Neurologist and ask them to make a referral. You should be referred to any or all of the above professionals if you are experiencing problems in the following areas:

Physiotherapy: Mobility problems, difficulty with walking or assessment for suitable walking aids. Assessment for: a suitable neck collar or foot splint. Advice on suitable exercises.

Occupational Therapy: Difficulties with activities of daily living (such as dressing, cooking, transfers (bed, chair, toilet, bathing etc.) and hand function.

Speech and Language Therapy: Problems with speech and communication, swallowing difficulties. Assessment for communication aids.

Dietitian: Weight loss, swallowing difficulties, problems with eating or drinking.

There are Community Neuro Therapy Teams throughout Hertfordshire, who consist of the above professionals. They can usually liaise directly with each other & can refer patients to each other within the Team.

MND ASSOCIATION - EQUIPMENT LOAN SERVICE

The MND Association has an equipment loan service offering a limited range of equipment, which is not normally supplied through a Statutory source. A referral needs to be requested by an appropriate Health & Social Care Professional, e.g., an Occupational Therapist or Speech and Language Therapist. These include communication aids (including voice banking and the loan of an iPad with relevant apps) and portable suction machines. You will need to be assessed first by a Health or Social Care Professional (Therapist or Social Worker) and they will complete the necessary paperwork to request the equipment. There is also a Communication Aids Service.

You can also apply for a financial support grant for financial help towards other items of equipment. Plus, there are other financial grants available
