Not only is the branch committed to help people affected by MND, including families and carers, we also welcome new volunteers and fundraisers to join us. We provide information, advice and support in a number of ways. As well as regular branch meetings we fund specialist equipment and services to meet your needs. We can also help fund courses for Professionals, holidays, days out, spa days, afternoon teas, anything that takes your fancy!

Accessible Holidays

Several of our members have been to the lovely Maison des Landes Hotel, Jersey.

Maison des Landes has been providing accessible accommodation for guests who have all manner of disabilities for more than forty years. Nestled in its own beautiful gardens the hotel is situated on a spectacular gorse and heather covered headland offering stunning panoramic views over Jersey's sweeping west coast and the Atlantic ocean. The hotel is a charitable trust set-up by the Lions Club of Jersey to provide holidays specifically for people with a disability along with their family, friends and carers. There is accommodation for 49 guests in 29 bedrooms, 18 of which are located on the Ground Floor. Most rooms have a fitted electric hoist (other rooms may use a mobile hoist), emergency call buttons, a walk-in/wheel-in shower, as well as a TV and tea/coffee-making facilities. Nine of the ground floor rooms are also fitted with electric beds (low pressure mattresses are available on request). The hotel holds a wide range of equipment that it is happy to loan free of charge during your stay and if they don't have an item in stock they will do their very best to obtain it for you, simply let them know what you need during the booking process.

The dining room is easily accessible and they are happy to cater for just about any dietary requirement you may have. There is a wide range of evening entertainment including bingo evenings, karaoke sessions, pub quizzes, ten-pin bowling, boules / petanque and visiting entertainers.

The hotel has a large indoor heated swimming pool specially designed with a wheelchair ramp and a hoist for ease of access and exit. Hotel staff are available to assist guests into and out of the pool and are on the poolside whenever it is in use. Transfers from the harbour or airport are included in the price of your stay and are accommodated in the hotel's own fleet of specially adapted mini-buses. The mini-buses are also put to good use transporting hotel guests out on daily sight-seeing tours. The tours visit major places of interest, including Jersey's Living Legend Village, Jersey War Tunnels, Eric Young Orchid Foundation, a Maizin! Adventure Park, The Gardens of Samares Manor, Durrell Wildlife Park, Shopping Centres and some of Jersey's magnificent beaches (including some that have the charity <u>BeachAbility</u>'s specially designed manual, ballooned wheelchairs for loan).

Evening tours featuring visits to the theatre, bowling etc. are also available according to demand and availability.

The hotel has single, double, twin or triple rooms, all of which are en-suite with some having walk in showers. Guest stay on a full board basis with all home cooked meals served in the dining room or outside in the hotels garden complete with aviary, weather permitting.

Named after Dorset writers Hardy, Barnes and Blyton, the wheelchair-accessible cottages have been lovingly restored to provide comfortable, tastefully furnished, year-round, single storey self-catering holiday accommodation for disabled people, their families, friends and carers.

Outdoors there are spacious landscaped gardens with tables and chairs for guests' use, providing stunning views across fields with farm animals and wildlife, to Bulbarrow Hill and Ibberton Hill. An heated indoor splash pool ha fully accessible changing rooms with showers and toilets, a pool hoist and a poolside seating area. A luxurious therapy room enables guests to be pampered by the visiting therapists. There is a recreation room with numerous books and games for all ages.
